Painting 1st-2nd grades ,Monday 18 spaces available
Painting 3rd-5th grades ,Tuesday

Instructor: Jamie Morgan

The mural class needs students who are committed to making drawings for a design and painting on plywood cutouts in order to add a new mural to our beautiful school and be counted among the young artists who have created murals at our school. The theme for the mural will be about birds. Students will identify different birds and their behaviors. They will draw birds flying, perching, and nesting. As with previous murals, Jamie will cut out enlarged plywood birds from students' drawings for them to paint.

The class will be divided between older and younger students so that each group can better develop their interests through the work on the mural. If there are enough students, Jamie will work with younger students one day and older students on the next *day each week. The class will also be devoted to painting projects on paper and canvas boards so that students can develop their own images and make their own finished paintings, as well as learn color mixing and other techniques useful in painting.*
