For the School Year 2011-2012, the P.E.A.C.E. Mural class will work on botanical signs for the gardens and a mural for the outside walls above the kindergarten and first grade classrooms. In the Fall, the older students (grades 3-5) will work on the botanical signs. These will be like the vegetable garden signs we did in this Spring, but will identify the other flowers and plants in the gardens. The younger students (grades 1-2) will start on the mural. In the Spring (2012) both groups will work on the mural.

As in the past lessons will start with drawing and students will paint their enlarged drawings on plywood. We will work on brush handling, use of color, and general painting skills. A big part of these school beautification projects involve teamwork and weekly participation in order for students to get the most out of the classes. There will be ten weeks of classes for both levels in the Fall and another ten in the Spring.
