2nd-5th Fridays

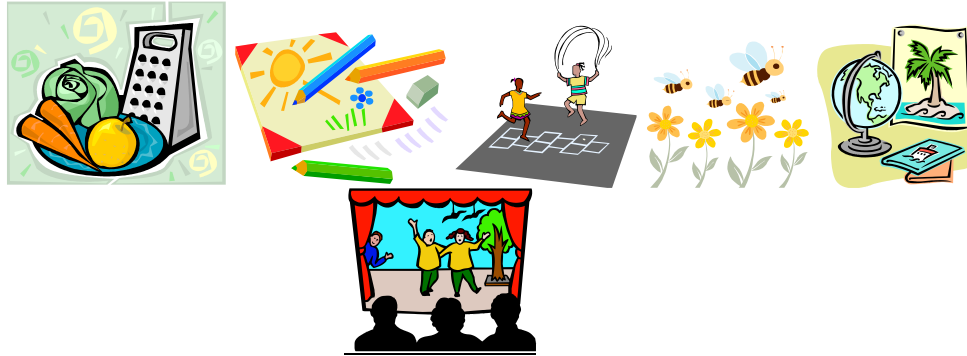
