

Peralta's gardens are a labor of love, many years in the making. They need your help.

Who keeps the gardens going at Peralta?

You do. And it's fun. Once a month Peralta families get together to tend to the gardens; sometimes planting a tree, sometimes weeding or raking, or pruning. Sometimes just getting to know the other parents a little better, or spending time with those parents you never have time to see. Sometimes it's just a cup of coffee while the little one(s) burn off some energy on a Saturday morning and you make the school a better place.

When do we work on Peralta's gardens?

The first or second Saturday of each month we designate a Garden Work Day. The work days officially start at 9am and end at 1pm. But you can stop by any time and stay for as long as you can.

What does 'sponsor' mean?

Each month a different class or group of classes sponsors that day. We ask the sponsors to provide snacks. Just because a certain class is 'sponsoring' a work day does not mean it is limited to members of that class.

Who can come?

Everyone is welcome. That means you, your child, grandparents, and sometimes even teachers and staff.

What do we do?

Mostly light gardening work, like weeding and pruning.

Do I need to have any experience?

Nope. No experience required. We'll find a job you're comfortable doing or will help you learn new skills.

What do I need to bring?

Perhaps some gloves as well as a snack and a bike or scooter for your child. Sunscreen? Hat? That's it.
